



Superfast broadband is coming your way

What's happening?

Openreach, the BT Group Business that looks after the country's communications infrastructure, is upgrading the network.

It's a massive £2.5 billion programme that will bring super-fast fibre broadband within reach of two-thirds of UK homes and businesses by 2014.

Right now, we're working up and down the country to put in the fibre-based equipment and cables that will underpin the communications infrastructure for the foreseeable future.

With blisteringly fast download speeds – of up to 100 MBit/s at the moment, increasing to 300 MBit/s during 2012 – it will leave current broadband lagging way behind.

We don't sell broadband. We provide the network infrastructure for over 400 different communications providers, from niche specialists to household names like Sky, BT and TalkTalk. That means residents have complete freedom to choose who they want to supply their super-fast broadband services.

Works in your area

KN Networks Services on behalf of Openreach will be carrying out works to facilitate the installation of the superfast fibre broadband. These works will involve excavating for the installation of a street cabinet and associated underground ducts. We will endeavour to keep walkways & pavements accessible at all times and to ensure the area is safe. The expected duration of the works will be approximately ten working days.
