ARDENTINNY COMMUNITY COUNCIL

There has been a proposal to erect a wind farm, consisting of 5 turbines, each 92.5 m high, on the hills above Cove. This will be fully visible to all villages on the shore. Financial benefit to all these villages, including Ardentinny, has been offered by Cove Community Trust. This will total approximately £22,500 per annum for at least 15 years, shared between the villages, and paid for from the Cove Trust's electricity generating fund. This money would be administered by an independent trust. A meeting was held on 24th November at Blairmore Hall, where information was presented and a discussion took place.

It is important that all residents in Ardentinny get an opportunity to obtain information and give their views on the proposal. If you missed the meeting in Blairmore Hall, there will be another opportunity to attend the presentation at the Dunoon Community Council meeting in the Queens Hall Dunoon on Monday 10^{th} December at 7 p.m..

Ardentinny Community Council will be giving residents in Ardentinny an opportunity to express their views when the planning application is submitted.
