October

We provided tea, coffee and home baking on open days during Cowalfest. The garden closed for the season when the schools opened after the holidays.

November

We were informed by the Co-op that we were successful in our bid for a grant to put in a composting toilet for all in the garden. Three local charities were successful therefore we will get 1/3 of the money raised from carrier bag sales and a share of the 1p donated on certain Co-op brands. We had a stall at Dunoon Dazzle and raised over £200. The winning raffle ticket for 10 car driver tickets was number 42.
